Nevertheless, it became obvious that publishing OHPD four times a year was no longer sufficient to publish the accepted manuscripts in due time. Therefore, we are very pleased that we could convince the Quintessence Publishing to increase the number of printed pages per year.

now on, we will print 6 issues per year with 96 pages each. This means 50% more good information for you, the readers.
