I am pleased to inform you that the *European Journal of Esthetic Dentistry* has been selected to be indexed and included in MEDLINE beginning with the first issue of April 2006. Citations from the articles indexed, the indexing terms, and the English abstract printed in the journal will be included and searchable using PubMed.

This is an important step forward for the *European Journal of Esthetic Dentistry*. I would like to thank all authors who have submitted their precious material to our journal without knowing if their work will be included in MEDLINE or not.

The *European Journal of Esthetic Dentistry* continues to grow. In 2010 we will have languages number five and six added to our list of international issues,

covering English, German, French, Spanish, Italian, and Greek. The first issue of 2010 will be published as a special issue dedicated to the Accademia Italiana di Conservativa, a very active group of Italian dentists. Many of them are also active members of the European Academy of Esthetic Dentistry (EAED). You will be pleased by the quality of their clinical work and the outstanding quality of their illustrations.

This issue features two articles from young talented colleagues (Dr Petra Guess from Germany and Dr Stavros Pelekanos from Greece) who participated last year in the EAED research competition. We are looking forward to getting more submissions from young talents in the future.



EAED Research Award

We proudly announce the 4th EAED Scientific Research Award (sponsored by 3i Implant Innovations, Spain). Clinicians and researchers are cordially invited to submit articles in the field of esthetic dentistry. All articles will be judged by the EAED Scientific Research Award Committee. The authors of the three best articles will be invited to the spring meeting in London, England, June 27–29th, 2010 and will receive prize money: first place, EUR 5,000; second place, EUR 3,000; and EUR 2,000 for third place. The articles will be published in the *European Journal of Esthetic Dentistry*, the EAED's official journal.

For this year's competition we welcome undergraduate and graduate students from dental schools to apply. We ask that our EAED members and colleagues, who are teaching professors, encourage their students to enter the competition.
