Robert Bösch, photographer and mountain guide with a university degree in geography has been working almost exclusively as a freelance photographer for more than 20 years. In addition to contract work for industry and advertising, he works for magazines and journals (including National Geographic Adventure, Stern, Geo, Spiegel and Schweizer Illustrierte). His travels and expeditions have led him to all continents exploring both the famous and less famous mountains.

Robert Bösch has authored many volumes of photographs and his title *Bergsteigen – Verlockung des Ungewissen* (“Mountaineering – the temptation of the unknown”) won him the *Internationaler Bergbuchpreis* (International Mountaineering Book Prize). Apart from books concerning the outdoors, he has carried out projects in other fields, including several books of photographs and reports covering topics such as hydroelectric power stations, the *Gotthardbahn* (Gotthard railway) and St. Moritz’s horseracing event “White Turf”. Robert Bösch is an opinion leader for Nikon and his images have been shown in different galleries, museums and exhibitions.
